WHEREAS, it is important to have a home fire escape plan that prepares your family to think fast and get out quickly when the smoke alarm sounds. and


WHEREAS, the 2012 National Fire Prevention Week theme "Have 2 Ways Out!" focuses on the importance of fire escape planning and practice; and
