RESOLUTION HONORING CAROL MOSELY AS A SANTA BARBARA RAPE CRISIS CENTER 2007 SHINING STAR

WHEREAS, Carol Mosely has been selected as a 2007 Shining Star by the Santa Barbara Rape Crisis Center in recognition of the contributions she has made to the quality of life in the community; and

WHEREAS, Carol Mosely has devoted her time and energies to advocacy and working in the sexual violence prevention field for over 20 years, and she has been a leader in the local anti-sexual violence movement since 1995 as Director of the Rape Prevention Education Program at the University of California, Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, through her work with UCSB, Carol Mosely and her team educate students about genderbased violence, provide direct services for survivors of sexual violence, and reach an average of 10,000 people yearly with vital information that changes beliefs, attitudes and behaviors; and

WHEREAS, Carol has been active in a number of capacities on a state and county-wide level, including serving as a member of the Santa Barbara County Sexual Assault Response Team (SART), a trainer with the California Police Officer Standards Training (P.O.S.T.) for officers responding to sexual assaults, and member of the county-wide Hate Crimes Network; and

WHEREAS, Carol Mosely served on the Board of Directors of Santa Barbara Rape Crisis Center, holding the offices of President, Vice President and Treasurer; and she was appointed in 2003 by Governor Gray Davis as a member of the California Campus Sexual Assault Task Force;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisor honors Carol Mosely as a recipient of the 2007 Santa Barbara Rape Crisis Center Shining Star Award and further commends her for a lifetime of outstanding leadership and dedicated service to ending sexual violence in our community and throughout the State of California.
