WHEREAS, Mr. Merrill manages 1,200 acres of wine grapes in Santa Barbara County for Mesa. Vineyard Management; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Merrill is the president of the Central Coast Wine Growers' Association, a board member of the Committee to Improve North County, and a member of the sleering committee for the Los Padres I and and Ag PAC; and

WHEREAS, through the Wine Industry Task Force, Mr. Merrill has brought together disparate interests from agriculture, government, environment and the community in general; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Merrill has been named the 2002 Farmer of the Year by the 37th District Agricultural Association.
