Title: DA - Increase Appropriations for OJP Services for Victims of Human Trafficking Federal Grant

Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$85,000 in District Attorney General Fund for Salaries and Employee Benefits (\$25,000) and Services and Supplies (\$60,000) funded by

unanticipated revenue from Intergovernmental Revenue-Federal for the OJP Services for Victims of Human Trafficking Federal grant award.

Justification: In FY 23-24, the District Attorney's Office Victim Witness Assistance Program was awarded its third consecutive grant from the Federal Department of Justice (DOJ)

under the Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) FFY 2023 Direct Services to Support Victims of Human Trafficking. The purpose of the grant award is to enhance victims' access to the diverse services that victims of labor and sex trafficking often require to address their needs. The total grant award for the Human Trafficking Victim Services Program is \$950,000, which will be allocated over the grant's multi-year project period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026. The total project cost is \$1,266,667, which includes the Federal award amount of \$950,000 and \$316,667 in County funds that serve as match for the program. The cash match is already included in the District Attorney's Fiscal Year 2023-24 Adopted Budget. The new award resulted in additional unanticipated FY 2023-24 revenue in the amount of \$85,000, including \$25,000 in Salaries & Employee Benefits costs for on-call Victim Witness Assistance Program staff to be available 24/7, as well as \$60,000 in Services & Supplies costs for contractual services. This budget revision request includes anticipated year-one costs, and future years' costs will be included in the budget

development process.
