SUBJECT: Construction of Bridge No. 51C-0346 on Old Coast Highway at Nojoqui Creek in the County of Santa Barbara. Federal Project No. BRLS-5951 (21) in the Third Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County; S.B. County Project No. 863019.

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, Griffith Company (Not a Local Vendor), 12631 E. Imperial Highway, Suite F-230, Santa Fe Springs, California 90670, in the amount of \$1,850,652.80.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The project consisted of replacing the existing arch type, 25 meter (82-foot) long concrete bridge over Nojoqui Creek. The new structure is 37 meters (121-feet) long and is a single-span bridge. The project was designed to accommodate two 3.6 meter (11.81-feet) lanes and two 1.2 meter (4.0-feet) shoulder lanes on each side of the bridge, and will convey the 100 - year storm event. Your Board approved this project on April 20, 2005 as part of the 2004/2005 Capital Improvement Plan. This project began on May 25, 2004 and the Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on October 13, 2005.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Funding for this project was provided through the Federally funded Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement (HBRR) program. The HBRR program provided 80% of the project funds with the remaining 20% from the County's Measure "D" revenues. Funding for the project is budgeted in Fund 0015, Org Unit 0022, Program 2900, Department 054 and Account 7510 and 7511 (Measure D).
