*WHEREAS, National Immunization Awareness Month highlights the importance of vaccination for people of all ages at local, state, and national levels; and*

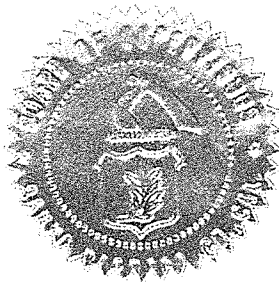
*WHEREAS, vaccination is one of the best ways for infants, children, teens, and adults to be protected from potentially harmful diseases; and*
