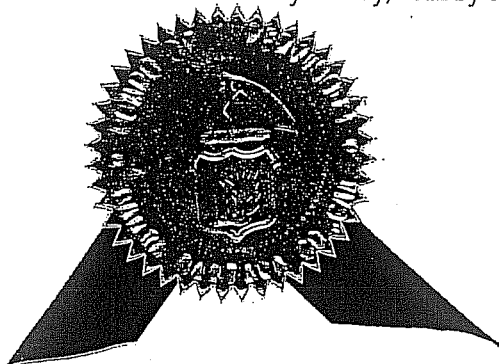
WHEREAS, our youth need the encouragement, inspiration, and guidance which we alone can give to develop those qualities essential for future leadership; and,
