WHEREAS, Paul Michael Weirum provided the citizens of Santa Barbara County extraordinary professionalism and sensitive law enforcement service while dedicating his life to the pursuit of justice and is known within the Sheriff's Office as the longest serving resident Deputy for Cuyama in Sheriff's Office history; and

WHEREAS, Paul Michael Weirum's knowledge, skills and experience contributed greatly to the overall professionalism and the goals of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office as well as the objectives of the County.
