

On April 20, 2010 at a residence fire in the 1100 block of North A St. Firefighter Shay ran into a burning garage and dragged a disoriented man outside just seconds before the garage door fell, which would have created a deathtrap for the man. It was Firefighter Shay's bravery and quick action that saved the man's life; and,
