SUBJECT: **Detached Trailer Ordinance, 5th Wheels and Equipment for a Period of 24 Hours on Public Roads and Right-of-Way. All Supervisorial Districts.**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

C.A. Recommendation: _____

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Set a public hearing for **June 18, 2002** to consider introduction of an ordinance adding Section 23-13.10 to Chapter 23 of the Santa Barbara County Code, prohibiting the parking of detached trailers, 5th wheels and equipment for a period of 24 hours or more on public roads and right-of-way.
- B. Conduct a second hearing on **June 25, 2002** and adopt the attached ordinance, adding Section 23-13.10 to Chapter 23 of the County Code.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with the following Goals: #2) Ensure the Public Health and Safety and Provide Essential Infrastructure, and #5) Maintain and Enhance the Quality of Life for all Residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

The Public Works Traffic Section has been requested to pursue an ordinance prohibiting the parking of detached trailers, 5th wheels and equipment for a period of 24 hours or more on public roads and rights-of-way. This equipment has proven to be a nuisance in many areas and wastes valuable residential parking space. Enforcement of the ordinance would be provided by the California Highway Patrol and Sheriff, and would primarily be on a complaint basis. This ordinance is consistent with existing ordinances of a number of cities within the county.

MANDATES & SERVICE LEVELS:

This item is not expected to result in any mandates or service level changes.

FACILITIES AND FISCAL IMPACT:

There are no facilities to be installed or fiscal impacts expected.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Clerk of the Board shall complete noticing for the ordinance in the Santa Barbara News Press 10 days prior to the hearing.

Clerk of the Board shall publish a summary once within 15 days after the adoption of the ordinance.
