Mr. Ron Pulice was an employee of Pulice Construction, Inc. from 1971 to 2009 when he sold the company. At Pulice Construction, Inc. he served in many capacities, including Chairman of the Board for 10 years (1996-2006) and as President from 1986-2000. Ron served on the Board of Associated General Contractors of America from 1980-1990, and served as its President in 1986 and 1989.

While living in Arizona, Ron was intimately involved in the development of the city of Phoenix in several different ways. His contracting company has been a major stakeholder in the construction of the urban freeway system in the greater Phoenix area. He privately developed residential property, serving on various boards in that sector. He also served on the Board of the Phoenix Economic Growth Council from 1988-2000, establishing missions in both Japan and China.

Ron served in the Phoenix public high school counseling program from 1992-1994 and worked as a counselor for the probation office in Phoenix. Following his participation in the Men's Movement in the 1980's, he initiated and continues to lead a Men's Poetry Group, currently in its 20th year.

Ron has also served on the board of The Archives and Research Center located on the campuses of Pacifica Graduate Institute in Santa Barbara, as its chairman.

At his property in Ellwood Canyon, California, he has been an avocado producer for 25 years. Ron has created a spiritual center and home for his family on the site using 19th century historical barns from New England. The property is used as a retreat center for friends, family, and private community events.

Mr. Pulice attended the University of Arizona, graduating in 1971 with a B.A. in Economics, and received his M.A. in Counseling Psychology from Pacifica Graduate Institute in 1993.
