That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the County of Santa Barbara Animal Services Director, or designee, to execute the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with AmeriCorps Seniors (RSVP) to provide recruitment and support of eligible volunteers that will allow more support to the shelters' operations for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026; and
- b) Determine that the recommended actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5), because the actions consist of organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

<u>Summary Text:</u> The item is on the agenda in order to approve and authorize the Memorandum of Understanding between Animal Services (SBCAS) and AmeriCorps Seniors to provide recruitment and support of eligible volunteers to supplement the current SBCAS volunteer program.

Background:

SBCAS has experienced significant impacts to its volunteer programs in the wake of COVID-19. SBCAS highly depends on reliable volunteers as they are an essential part of the shelter operations, not only assisting with keeping the shelters clean and sanitary, but also providing care for the animals and supporting the front office administrative tasks. Partnering with AmeriCorps Seniors (RSVP) will create an opportunity for SBCAS to connect with new volunteers and increase community engagement while
