WHEREAS, today, thanks to vaccines, childhood diseases such as polio and measles are rarely seen in this country and infections that once devastated families are no longer common threats; and

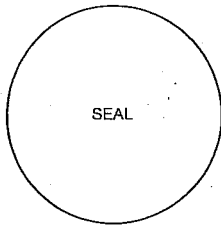
WHEREAS, other serious diseases, such as whooping cough and influenza, continue to affect the health of our families and communities; and
