Congratulations, the local Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) proposal submitted on behalf of Santa Barbara County has been cleared for funding by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) technical review. In the next step, BSCC has begun the process of developing a grant agreement for funding prior to the grant start date. As a reminder, counties who have not submitted Governing Board Resolution should do so at this time. The CESF grant funding to the county **cannot** proceed without the Governing Board Resolution.
