**Description of Services**

- 1. Coastal Copy, Inc. (#180386)** – Contractor provides service, parts, and labor for printing related tasks throughout the County. They will also include travelling to certain locations to help fix printers, scanners, and copiers as well as remote monitoring to ensure equipment is functioning properly.

Current using department(s): All County Departments

- 2. Herencia Indigena, LLC (#118764)**– Contractor provides interpretation services throughout Santa Barbara County. Interpreters/advocates will facilitate in communication between parties, assist with appointments with patients, and perform other Mixteco to English tasks such as providing educational materials.

Current using department(s): Social Services, County Health, Child Support Services

- 3. Marborg Industries (#509950)** - In addition to trash and waste-related services, Contractor also provides other non-standard services including, but not limited to, street sweeping services, special item hauls, equipment repair, and temporary fencing. Certain rental equipment such as portable bathrooms and washing stations are also included.

Current using departments: Behavioral Wellness, Community Services, Sheriff, General Services, Public Works – Laguna County Sanitation, Public Works – RRWM, Fire

- 4. Pacific Petroleum (#789281)** – Contractor collects, transfers, and disposes both hazardous and non-hazardous materials throughout the County. Services also include cleaning these materials and providing equipment such as backhoes, graders, compactors, excavators, forklifts, air compressors, and generators.

Current using departments: Public Works – Laguna County Sanitation, Clean Water, and RRWM

- 5. Tetra Tech, Inc. (#806815)** - Contractor provides inspections, monitoring, and document preparation of oil spill control, stormwater, and surface water regulations. These services support areas such as the landfill gas system, material recovery facility, and composting operations by providing studies, assistance with documents, permitting, design, construction support, and operations.

- 6.
