Executive Summary and Discussion:

Tract 5763 (Foxenwood Townhomes) is located within the boundaries of the Laguna County Sanitation District and the District will collect, treat and dispose of the tract's wastewater. The area was annexed into the city of Santa Maria in 1990 with the Local Area Formation Commission (LAFCO) describing sewer and water service by the Laguna County Sanitation District and Cal Cities Water Company.

The tract was approved by the city on January 7, 2004 and recorded on January 13, 2004 in Book 189, Pages 46-49. The city of Santa Maria approved and accepted other improvements but formal acceptance of the dedicated sewer easement as described in the map's Owner's Statement must be accepted by the Laguna County Sanitation District.
