WHEREAS, providing access to nutritious food and better information creates healthier people who make positive choices for themselves and their families; and

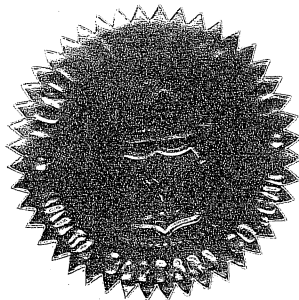
WHEREAS supporting sustainable family farms and local agriculture benefits the local economy; and
