RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING PAUL LADWIG FOR HIS 30 YEARS OF DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Paul retired from the Department of Social Services on July 31, 2021, after 30 years of dedicated Public Service during which time he served as an Eligibility Worker, Eligibility Lead Worker, and Department Liaison with community partner agencies; and

WHEREAS, Paul modeled his professional leadership in a way that always focused on the needs of others, the community, best practices, and the public we serve, rather than himself; and

WHEREAS, Paul provided excellent representation of the Department of Social Services both in the department and at community outreach events such as with the Federal Correctional Institution Lompoc Federal Bureau of Prisons (FCI Lompoc - BOP). He volunteered for this assignment to provide information and access to much needed services in the areas of safety and health to the general population. Paul's participation in these events improved the wellbeing of the most vulnerable in our communities; and

WHEREAS, Paul's knowledge, skills and experience proved immeasurable in providing technical guidance and assistance to colleagues, line staff, and management during planning and response to the Lompoc River Park Homeless Triage Center project, during Administrative Reviews, and during the COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors recognizes Paul Ladwig for his 30 years of dedicated public service to the residents of Santa Barbara County.
