WHEREAS, to maintain the confidentiality and integrity of this assignment including the role in providing executive support, handling items of a confidential and sensitive nature, recommending process improvement of various departmental operations, and supervision of staff, there is a need for maximum flexibility in the hiring and retaining of the employee in the Department Business Specialist I/II-Restricted position in the County Executive Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

Effective January 24, 2022, the Department Business Specialist I/II-Restricted position in the County Executive Office shall be exempt from the Civil Service System of the County of Santa Barbara and will serve in the capacity of an "at-will" employee at the pleasure of the County Executive Officer.
