Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolutions (4) and approve Notice of Exemption pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for the establishment of no parking zones on:

- Turnpike Road in the Goleta area; 2nd Supervisorial District
- Cieneguitas Road in the Goleta area; 2nd Supervisorial District
- Hummel Drive in the Orcutt area; 4th Supervisorial District
- Dahlia Place in the Orcutt area; 4th Supervisorial District

Summary Text:

Several requests were received from citizens in the Goleta and Orcutt areas, addressing safety concerns related to parking at various locations in the County of Santa Barbara.

Based upon our investigation, the Public Works Department has prepared the attached Resolutions (4) establishing parking restrictions at the following locations:

ADOPT

No Parking Zone

• On the east side of Turnpike Road between Cervato Way and Cathedral Oaks Road.

No Parking Zone

- On the west side of Cieneguitas Road from a point 40 feet north of the centerline of S.R. 192 to a point 210 feet north of the centerline of S.R. 192.
- On the east side of Cieneguitas Road from a point 40 feet north of the centerline of S.R. 192 to a point 150 feet north of the centerline of S.R. 192.

ADOPT

No Parking Zone

- On the east side of Hummel Drive from a point 48 feet north of the centerline of Hobbs Lane to a point 343 feet south of the centerline of Mooncrest Lane
- On the west side of Hummel Drive from the centerline of Hobbs Lane to a point 241 feet south of the centerline of Mooncrest Lane.

No Parking Zone

• On the north side of Dahlia Place from a point 43 feet east of the centerline of Loch Lomond Drive to point 133 feet east of the centerline of Loch Lomond Drive

Background:

Parking restrictions are either established or rescinded based on safety, necessity and how it relates to the use by the community as a whole. All of these factors are weighed by the Traffic Section and any changes recommended are presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval. These parking restrictions may include no parking, time limited parking, loading zones, vehicle height restricted parking, angle parking, handicapped parking or any combination of these restrictions.

Turnpike Road:

The request for no parking was initiated by the the citizens of Goleta and also associated with several construction projects in the area and the restriping of sections of this roadway.

Cieneguitas Road:

The request for a no parking zone was initiated by the citizens of Goleta and also associated with several construction projects in the area and the restriping of sections of this roadway.

Hummel Drive:

The request for a no parking zone was initiated by an agreement between the County Public Works Department and the residents fronting the Hummel Drive Extension Project in the Orcutt Area to narrow the roadway and to minimize the impacts of the extension project.

Dahlia Place:

The request for a no parking zone was initiated by citizens in the Orcutt area due to safety concerns with sight distance concerns on this section of roadway.






