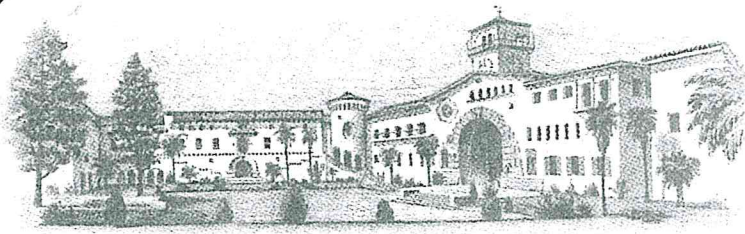

**RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR
APRIL IRVING, SENIOR DEPUTY PROBATION OFFICER
FOR OVER 20 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE
TO THE CITIZENS AND COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA**

WHEREAS, April Irving was born in Santa Barbara and graduated from Santa Maria High School. April earned an Associates of Arts Degree in General Studies at Cuesta College, a certificate in Computer Accounting from Santa Barbara Business College, as well as a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Kaplan University; and

WHEREAS, Officer Irving was hired as a full-time Juvenile Institutions Officer (JIO) in 1998 at the Santa Maria Juvenile Hall, and enjoyed four years as a JIO before being promoted to a Senior JIO in 2002. Due to her vast knowledge and excellent leadership skills, she was promoted to a Supervising Juvenile Institutions Officer in 2006; and

WHEREAS, Officer Irving became a Senior Deputy Probation Officer through a classification consolidation, enabling her to transition to an Intake position in the Lompoc Investigations Unit where she was responsible for reviewing all incoming law enforcement referrals, and making appropriate referrals to community providers based on a thorough assessment of each case. She transitioned to the Santa Maria Juvenile Field Supervision Unit in 2012 as a lead officer, and subsequently returned to an Intake position where she has enjoyed making a positive impact on youth, while giving them an opportunity to divert from the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, Officer Irving is looking forward to spending time with her wife Josette, three sons, Dustin, Steven and Gregory, and her eight grandchildren, she is planning on adventuring to New York, taking an Alaskan cruise, and frolicking at Universal Studios, all while making many new memories with her family.
