Summary:

For Superior Court, this project remodels approximately 9,900 square feet of the County-owned facility at 118 E. Figueroa Street to meet requirements of the American Disabilities Act (ADA) and provide a new waiting room to improve customer service. Lack Construction, Inc., a local vendor, is the low bidder.

Background:

Superior Court will remodel approximately 9,900 square feet of the basement and first floor office areas in the North wing of the County-owned facility at 118 E. Figueroa Street. The remodel will create space that facilitates an efficient and effective Court operation by providing increased and ADA accessible office space, counter space and ADA compliant restrooms. It will also provide a children's waiting room for their customers. This space was previously occupied by the District Attorney. When the District Attorney vacated this space to move into their new building, the space was allocated to Superior Courts on the following conditions:

- 1.) Superior Court vacated an existing lease the County was paying for on Carrillo Street.
- 2.) Superior Court moved out of the southerly half of the modular building in the rear parking lot. The Sheriff occupied this space temporarily, but have since moved into permanent space. The Board has previously directed to make this space available for the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA). This space will not be transferred to the State as part of SB 1732 since CASA's use of the space is a County function.

There were 7 bids submitted for the Superior Court Remodel project. Lack Construction, Inc., the low bidder, has been determined to be a responsible company capable of performing this work, and their bid is deemed a responsive bid. Their bid of \$985,605 is lower than the construction estimate for this project.

Because the County owns and maintains this facility, Board of Supervisors approval is required for this construction. The Figueroa Court building is scheduled to be transferred to the State in accordance with SB 1732. No change in service levels.
