

COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING OCTOBER DYSLEXIA AWARENESS MONTH IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, in an effort to assist parents, educators and individuals, the International Dyslexia Association has designated October as Dyslexia Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health defines dyslexia as an inheritable and highly prevalent language based disability affecting 1 in 5 individuals; and

WHEREAS, dyslexia, meaning "difficulty with words," constitutes one of the several distinct learning disabilities and is characterized by challenges in processing language when decoding oral and written words; and

WHEREAS, children with dyslexia, especially those who are not identified and are reading below grade level at the end of third grade, often experience difficulties with depression, anxiety, and poor self-image and rarely catch up to their peers. As a result, they underperform in school and are at a greater risk for dropping out before completing high school; and

WHEREAS, with proper diagnosis, appropriate instruction, accommodations, access to assistive technologies, and support from families, teachers and friends, individuals with dyslexia can excel in school and continue on to pursue exciting and distinguished careers that fulfill their potential;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims October, 2014 as "Dyslexia Awareness Month" in Santa Barbara County and encourages all citizens to support those affected by dyslexia and recognize the efforts to raise awareness and prevent problems associated with dyslexia.
