# **Recommended Actions:**

Consider recommendations regarding amendments to contracts for adult mental health services as follows:

- 1. Approve and execute an amendment to the contract with Aurora Vista del Mar Hospital (not a local vendor) to continue providing acute hospital services to adults with severe mental illness for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$600,000.
- 2. Approve and execute an amendment to the contract with Crestwood Behavioral Health Center, Inc. (not a local vendor), an institute for mental disease, to continue to provide a mental health rehabilitation center program for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$280,000.
- 3. Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contracts, provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of each contract's dollar amount.

# **Summary Text:**

Aurora Vista del Mar (Aurora) provides acute Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Services to adults with severe mental illness (SMI). Aurora provides observation and treatment for clients admitted involuntary

because they are determined to be a danger to themselves or others, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code 5150. Crestwood Behavioral Health (Crestwood) is an Institution for Mental Disease (IMD) that provides 24-hour psychiatric mental health treatment for chronic, psychiatrically-impaired County clients. Approval of the recommended actions will renew the agreements for FY 08-09.

# **Background:**

Aurora Vista del Mar (Aurora), located in Ventura, is one of the closest facilities accepting client referrals from Alcohol, Drug, and Mental Health Services (ADMHS). Aurora provides Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Services such as psychiatric assessment, medication management, and therapeutic services to clients requiring one-to-one intensive supervision. The services are designed to stabilize clients as rapidly as possible and return them to an improved level of functioning. Aurora is the primary acute inpatient hospital providing services to county clients in need of hospitalization when Santa Barbara County Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) is at capacity. ADMHS continues to experience a high volume of involuntary hospitalizations at Aurora since Cottage Hospital relinquished its "5150" designation and no longer accepts involuntary psychiatric clients. Clients may be referred to the San Luis Obispo County PHF as space allows, however, scarce local resources and a PHF that is regularly at capacity, has resulted in considerable growth in the number of individuals with acute SMI being placed at Aurora.

**Crestwood,** located in Bakersfield, operates a twenty-four hour Mental Health Rehabilitation Center. This Institute for Mental Disease (IMD) provides intensive psychiatric mental health treatment, medical assessment, diagnosis, and monitoring, and treatment groups for clients diagnosed with co-occurring disorders. The services are designed to return the client to community-living through an active daily living and symptom management program.

<u>Performance Measure:</u> Approval of the recommended actions will assist ADMHS in meeting the following **Recurring Performance Measures:** 

**RPM 0230** to provide effective mental health care to 5,200 seriously mentally ill adults.

In FY 06-07, Aurora provided 1,821 hospital bed days to 253 ADMHS clients with an average length of stay of 7.2 days. ADMHS has implemented utilization review and control measures to ensure appropriate and effective bed day usage.

In FY 06-07, Crestwood provided 1858 hospital bed days to ten ADMHS clients.

Mental Health Services are mandated by the Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 5600.
