### **CANNABIS TAXES**

Table 1 provides a comparison of third quarter tax revenue data received from the Treasurer Tax-Collector's Office for this fiscal year versus the last three fiscal years. Total taxes paid (for the first three quarters of the fiscal year) is \$3.9 million. The revised fiscal year end projection for the full 12 months is \$5.4 million, which is \$700,000 below the adopted budgeted amount of \$6.1 million.




FIGURE 1. TAX REVENUE COMPARISON FY 21-22 TO 24-25 BY QUARTER

Table 2 provides a breakdown of operators required to report their quarterly gross tax receipts. Note that the two operators that did not report are not currently in operation; they do not hold active State licenses or County cannabis business licenses.

#### CANNABIS PERMITTING: LAND USE ENTITLEMENT PERMITS

As of May 29, 2025, there are 138.11 acres of cannabis cultivation and processing activities within the Carpinteria Overlay area that are entitled with approved permits, and 1,356.65 acres of cannabis cultivation and processing activities within the remaining Unincorporated area outside of the Carpinteria Overlay that are entitled with approved permits. Of those approved acres, 137.54 acres within the Carpinteria Agricultural Overlay area and 1,189.68 acres in the remaining unincorporated area outside of the Carpinteria Overlay area have been permitted with an issued land use entitlement. The table below summarizes the amount of cultivation and processing acreage that has been applied for, and the amount of cultivation and processing acreage that has been approved and permitted as of May 29, 2025, through the land use entitlement process. These numbers reflect active and/or vested permits and do not include acreage that was proposed under land use entitlement applications that were submitted and then later withdrawn or expired.

- 1. Submitted permit acreage can fluctuate based on project redesigns or changes to proposed cultivation areas.
- 2. An applicant may apply for a business license upon approval of their land use entitlement.
- 3. The "Issued Permit Acreage" is a subset of the "Approved Permit Acreage". A land use entitlement can only be issued after it has been approved.
- 4. The approved acreage can fluctuate down from previous quarterly data due to changes to approved projects during the appeal process or when a project is withdrawn after approval.

Note: All submitted, approved and issued acreage listed above includes both cultivation and processing acres.

To date, P&D has received 102 unique appeals of 65 cannabis projects. Of the 102 appeals received, 98 have been withdrawn, closed, or action has been taken by the decision maker. There is currently one active appeal to the County Planning Commission, which is the Appeal of the Valley Crest Change in Hours of Operation. The Appeal of the G&K Processing Building Design Review is the only active appeal to the County Board of Supervisors.
