On March 14, 1995, your Board created the Agricultural Advisory Committee. The composition was to include one appointee by each member of the Board and one member from each of the following groups, to be ratified by the Board:

- Central Coast Wine Growers Association
- Grower-Shipper Vegetable Association
- Santa Barbara County Cattlemen's Association
- Santa Barbara County Farm Bureau
- Santa Barbara County Nursery and Flower Growers Association

At your April 9, 2002, meeting, your Board approved the nomination of alternates to the Agricultural Advisory Committee by each of the member groups for appointment by your Board.
