

## Laguna County Sanitation District







- Dependent special district created in 1958
- Provides wastewater services to Orcutt and unincorporated Santa Maria area
- Regulated by:
  - RWQCB Order R3-2020-0220 (plant)
  - SWRCB Order WQ 2016-0068-DDW (reclamation)
  - EPA (brine disposal well)
  - SWRCB 2022-0103-DWQ (sewer system)
  - SWRCB (operator licensing)
  - SWRCB 2014-0057-DWQ (industrial)
  - APCD (air emissions)
- Conserves and protects water resources

#### **Current Activities**

Phase 1 plant upgrade in progress





#### Annual Rates and Fees Ordinance

- Public noticing pursuant to Prop 218
  - Mailer to 13,158 customers on 11,003 parcels
- Hearing date published pursuant to Government Code in Santa Maria Times
- A small number of written responses (less than 1%)



#### Sewer Charge Rates

- Pay for annual operation, maintenance, replacement, and reserves
- Collected on the tax roll
- 1.5% increase proposed for FY 2024-2025
  - Per rate study
  - CPI was 3.5% (annual 2023 average)

#### Proposed Sewer Charge

Residential unit equivalent (RUE) rate

```
Proposed annual rate $1,138.37

<u>Last year's rate</u> $1,121.55

Rate increase/year $ 16.82
```

Equivalent to \$1.40/month (monthly rate of \$94.86)

```
Multiple Family Residential = $924.79/year
```

School = \$59.05 per cap/year

Commercial = Based on flow and load

# Developer Charges and Fees



- Paid by development for sewer system equity buy-in
  - Trunk line fees fund collection system improvements
  - Connection charges fund treatment and discharge improvements

#### Developer Charges and Fees

- Fees adjusted per index as prescribed by ordinance or agreement
- Connection charge per RUE (CCI = 9.4%) \$10,676
- Trunk Line Fees
  - Dutard trunk line per RUE (CCI = 9.4%) \$1,363
  - Bradley trunk line per RUE (PR = 8.5%) \$3,498
