AS THE 2012 PLANNED PARENTHOOD **VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR**

WHEREAS, Richard W. Jensen is being honored by Planned Parenthood of Santa Barbara, Ventura and San Luis Obispo Counties (PPSBVSLO) with the Volunteer of the Year Award. For nearly 50 years, Mr. Jensen has been a devoted volunteer to PPSBVSLO, because he strongly believes in the importance of a woman's right to choose how, when and where she will have children; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jensen has demonstrated his commitment by serving several terms on the PPSBVSLO Board of Directors, including a term as Board Chair, volunteering countless hours of his time and expertise as a finance expert, as well as serving as the Santa Barbara Campaign Chair of PPSBVSLO's Healthy Families Healthy Communities campaign and on the Planned Parenthood Federation of America Board and Finance Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jensen has demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to the Santa Barbara community where he has served and provided leadership for several other boards including the Unitarian Society, the City Aquatics Complex Task Force, the Community Environmental Council, and the Las Positas Park (Elings Park) Foundation: and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jensen, an economist and planning consultant, has had broad experience in planning and technology at both campus and University-wide levels. He is Co-editor for the Society on College and University Planning's "Technology Driven Planning: Principles to Practice" 2000; and lecturer on planning at SCUP and University of California conferences; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jensen, after retiring as Associate Chancellor of Planning & Budget at University of California, Santa Cruz, went on to serve as Assistant Chancellor of Planning and Analysis and Interim Assistant Vice Chancellor for Alumni Affairs at University of California, Santa Barbara.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Richard W. Jensen as the recipient of Planned Parenthood Volunteer of the Year Award and further recognizes his lifelong commitment to activism, leadership, advocacy and dedicated service to his community.
