SUBJECT: Authorization for Director of Planning and Development to Issue a Notice to Proceed

to URS Corporation for preparation of the Environmental Impact Report for the Ocean Meadows project, P&D Case Numbers 03GPA-00000-00003, 03RZN-00000-00002, 03TRM-00000-00002, 03DVP-00000-00022. The project site is located in the Goleta area, south of the Highway 101 and Storke Avenue interchange, Third Supervisorial District; APN 073-090-062. The EIR cost is \$135,190 plus a contingency of

\$10,000.00 for a total not to exceed cost of \$145,190.00.

Recommendation:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Planning and Development to issue a Notice to Proceed to the consulting firm of URS Corporation for preparation of the Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Ocean Meadows project.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with actions required by law and by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The firm of URS Corporation is on P&D's list of firms approved by the Board of Supervisors to provide environmental services. URS Corporation was selected by the Joint Review Panel as part of the

implementation of the Joint Proposal for the Ellwood-Devereux Coast. A copy of the Scope of Work is included as Attachment A.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change in programs or service levels. The Board adopted process for using consultant services contracts for environmental impact report (EIR) preparation is a permissible method under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and allows the County to meet CEQA-mandated time lines for EIR consultant contracting.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Costs for consultant selection, preparation, and processing of the environmental document are borne by the applicant.
