Subject: Galileo Pisa density, Community Plan issues, removal of mature median landscaping, and traffic safety concerns. 360+ residents concerned.

Dear Supervisor Hartmann:

On behalf of 360+ local residents who have concerns about the impacts from high density development proposals, I'm writing in opposition to the proposed three story apartment project slated for the avocado orchard at the intersection of Calle Real and Patterson Avenue. Put simply, this proposal is out of scale (too tall), monolithically designed (one large structure), and too dense (up to 417% more density than the nearby neighborhoods). Additionally, the proposed access is a potential risk to traffic safety and will result in the loss of mature landscape.

Prior public hearings have not yielded a significant discussion about site design, access/traffic safety, and density. *SBAR made it clear that they would not get into density or access issues* (saying that those were issues for the Planning Commission). *At the December 2021 Planning Commission hearing, commissioners avoided a substantive discussion on access/traffic safety, density, and site design, when several commissioners wrongly assumed that, "SBAR must certainly have discussed these issues"* (paraphrasing). By that point, public comment had been closed and the neighborhood's concerns were not given full consideration.

Given the lack of significant discussion by SBAR and the PC, it's our hope that the Board will have an open and thorough conversation on the concerns raised in this letter.

While I have supported the applicant on one of her prior projects (Patterson Plus Storage) and I support her right to build a reasonable project that is in-keeping with the neighborhood, this current proposal is simply too dense, avoids a key component of the Eastern Goleta Valley Community Plan (EGVCP), and it poses aesthetic and traffic safety concerns.

Ironically, when a recent proposal on another nearby parcel posed a similar traffic safety and planning issues, the Galileo Pisa applicant joined the neighborhood in opposing that project with concerns similar to the ones the neighborhood now has about the applicant's Galileo Pisa project. See the applicant's own quotes about that project in Addendum C.

Here is a summary of our concerns:

- **Density is Out of Place:** Galileo is proposing a three story structure that is up to 417% denser than the existing neighborhood. Its three story single-structure design creates a monolithic mass out of character with the neighborhood and ignores the EGVCP directive to A) cluster the structures and B) place parking behind structures.
- **Removal of Mature Median Landscape:** As proposed, Galileo's access turn lane will wipe out the existing mature trees and landscaping area Calle Real just west of Patterson Avenue. This existing landscape median is an integral and natural aesthetic that welcomes people into the City of Goleta. Ironically, the "Tree City, USA" sign for the City of Goleta is just steps away from the area proposed for removal.

- Access and Traffic Safety Concern: The same proposed turn lane that will remove the existing landscaping is fraught with potential challenges. Motorists and cyclists turning from Patterson onto west bound Calle Real are focused/distracted by **1)** the behavior of other drivers (two lanes turning from Patterson), and **2)** direct glare from the setting sun during the afternoon rush hour - - installing a new left turn lane with these conditions poses a threat to safety. Neither of the above points are referenced in the traffic study. **See Addenda A and B.**

Further, the proposed left turn lane is 35% shorter than the existing left turn lane into the applicant's adjacent property (a self-storage facility with dramatically fewer turns than residential). It's also 45% smaller than the adjacent east bound turn lane into Orchard Park Lane. Given these dynamics, this is not a suitable location for a left turn lane.

- Not Following a Key EGVCP Element: This project places the parking up front (along Calle Real) which conflicts with EGVCP guidance to place parking behind the structures (and out of view). The bulk and scale of the single three story building are likely driven by the applicant's desire to maximize density - - that desire ignores the EGVCP guideline to emphasize aesthetics.

You can read our attached submission to staff on the Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for a more detailed view of our concerns (letter dated 6.12.21).

Recommendation and Request

This project will impact thousands of residents on a daily basis. As stated above, I believe a reasonable project can be approved based on the following elements:

1. Clustered Two Story Structures with Parking Behind the Structures: Follow the EGVCP guideline by placing parking behind the structures. Break up the current single mass structure in favor of clustered buildings. Two story maximum while maintaining view corridors. We disagree with the Staff Report that the current three story design with parking up front is compatible with EGVCP guidelines:

DevStd VIS-EGV-1E: "Development along State Street, Hollister Avenue, Calle Real, and Turnpike Road should enhance existing view corridors. Parking lots and other impervious surfaces should be placed in side and rear, rather than frontage, areas in all development along community corridors."

VIS-EGV-1A states "Limit the height and size of structures. Cluster building sites and structures. Design buildings along scenic local routes to help protect views and create an attractive scenic corridor. On flat sites, vary or step building heights so that the height of building elements is lower close to the street and increases with distance from the street."

VIS-EGV-1.6 states, "Development shall be compatible in design and scale with the surrounding built environment and shall not impair public visual resources." It is difficult to conclude how Galileo Pisa's density (up to 417% more) is compatible in scale with the surrounding neighborhoods.

I can't recall a project in the Goleta Valley where staff or your Commission has required the application of this "should" language on an applicant. If ever there was a project to enforce this language, Galileo Pisa is it. The applicant's design is solely driven by density (ie: contending that the three story design compels the applicant to place the parking up front to preserve views). **Rather, a two story clustered design with the structures in the front of the property would preserve views, increase**

compatibility with the neighborhood, and allow the parking to be placed behind the structures.

2. Access: Utilize the existing left turn lane from west Calle Real that serves the Applicant's self-storage facility. U-turns are currently allowed at this location (or the Applicant could facilitate access to the new apartments through adjacent her self-storage property). **See Addendum A.**
3. Density: At its current proposed density the project is up to 417% denser than surrounding neighborhoods and it needs a redesign to improve compatibility. Direct the applicant to scale back the number of units within the design parameters above.

I would be happy to meet or talk with you as your schedule allows. Please review the attached list of concerned area residents. Together with online registrations, more than 360 neighbors have expressed concern.

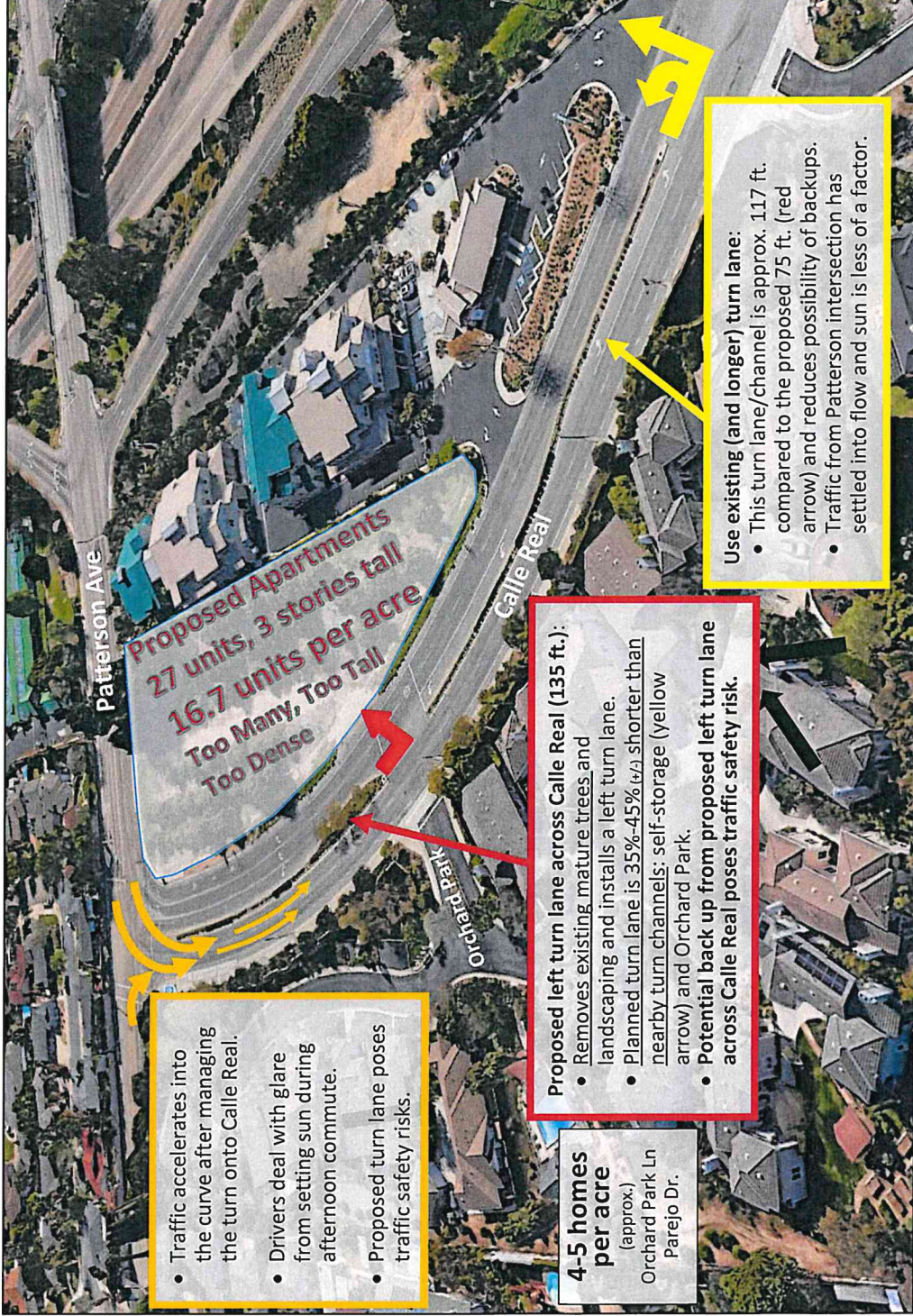

High Density Three Story Apartment Complex Poses Potential Traffic Safety and Neighborhood Compatibility Concerns

ADDENDUM A



1. Too Many, Too Tall, Too Dense: Three story 27 unit project -- approximately 333%-417% higher density than the neighborhood (16.7 units per acre vs. 4 to 5 per acre).

2. Design and Parking: Proposed three story monolithic structure should be broken up into smaller two story clustered buildings, parking lot should be located behind the apartments rather than along Calle Real, mountain views preserved (consistent with Community Plan).

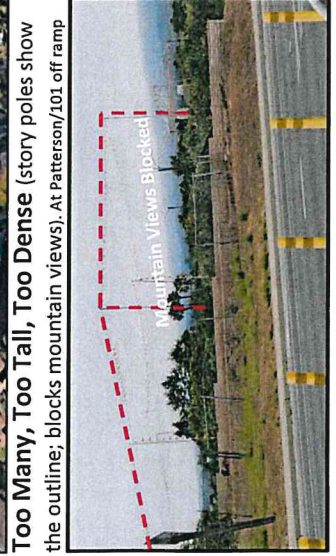
3. Demolition of Gateway Median Landscape Buffer: Mature and established landscape to be removed for a turn lane (across Calle Real). Ironic given the nearby "Tree City USA" road sign.

4. Wrong Place for Turn Lane: Accelerating traffic from Patterson onto Calle Real will deal with potential back-ups in the proposed turn lane, cars merging from another lane, and have direct sun in eyes during p.m. rush hour.

5. Turn Lane Too Short: The proposed turn channel of 75 feet is 35%-45% smaller than existing turn channels yet the proposed project generates more traffic than its neighbors.

6. Use Existing Turn Lane (yellow): At 205+/- ft., the existing turn lane is 52% longer than the proposed Galileo turn lane and farther away from traffic navigating the turn onto Patterson Ave.

ADDENDUM B: KEY PICTURES (1 of 2)



#1: Mature landscape to be removed for a turn lane that is 40% smaller than the Orchard Park turn lane - - even though Galileo Pisa proposes 35% MORE units than Orchard Park).

Tree removal irony given the "Tree City USA" sign just steps away.



#2: Rush hour glare faces confronts both lane of drivers immediately after navigating the turn from Patterson and accelerating past proposed (and short) Galileo left turn lane.



#3: Safety cones routinely left to alert turning traffic. Drivers in both left turn lanes focused on each other as they navigate the turn and accelerate.



#4: "Keep Clear" should remain the guiding principle and compel alternative access for Galileo Pisa.



#5: Traffic studies don't factor in actual experiences. Unanticipated backups at the Turnpike Starbucks.

Subject: Galileo Pisa Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) Comments

Dear Mr. Stewart:

Thank you for your time when we last spoke and I appreciate your work on behalf of the community. As noted, I've reviewed the MND dated May 24, 2021 on the proposed Galileo Pisa project and offer the below comments:

1. **1.0 Project Description** (page 1): Consider standardizing all references throughout the document) to the phrase "up to 20-units per acre" rather than "20-units per acre." Similarly, when referring to the project description here and elsewhere in the MND, consider referencing the monolithic design (ie: "...a single-building apartment project consisting of 27,723 square feet") to clarify the applicants design (compared to the "clustered" structure design guideline in the Eastern Goleta Valley Community Plan (EGVCP).

2. **3.0 Environmental Setting** (page 2): In referencing the number and condition of the avocado trees (in this section and elsewhere in the MND), request the applicant retain an arborist to verify the condition of the trees and review Goleta Water District usage records before and after the applicant purchased the subject property.

Additionally, please confirm that the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) certification was conducted to residential use standards as the subjects were likely zoned commercial and agricultural at the time of the remediation.

3. **4.0 Methodology for Evaluating Cumulative Impacts** (page 3): Given the close proximity of the proposed left turn lane to the increasingly busy Patterson/Calle Real intersection, consider expanding the "vicinity" being evaluated to include the Tree Farm project and the pending Cottage Hospital project at the corner of Hollister and Patterson. Both of these significant projects have already (or will) impact this corridor.

4. **5.1 Aesthetics/Visual Resources** (page 3): The viewshed areas should also include the intersection of Patterson and the 101 northbound off ramp at Patterson.

(page 4): Visual resources and obstruction of public views are compromised by a three story monolithic structure which disregards the EGVCP guidelines to A) cluster structures (rather than create one large structure), and B) place the parking behind the structures. Based on these two points of contention with the EGVCP, we disagree with the statement "...the project would not create an aesthetically offensive site plan open to public view or visually incompatible structures." Further, the proposal is even asking for an exception to the current height restriction.

(page 5): With a proposed density of 16.7 units per acre, we disagree with the statement "The project has been designed to be compatible with the surrounding development." The proposed density is 333%-417% greater than the existing single family neighborhood (four to five units per acre).

5. **5.3a Air Quality** (page 6): Although this section discusses impacts as a result of the construction and ongoing operations of the proposed project, consider adding a review of the health and safety impacts on the future residents of this project due to its close proximity to the 101 freeway and onramp (well within the historic 500 ft. guidance by the California Air Resources Board). Additionally the project is adjacent to the signalized intersection of Calle Real and Patterson which generates potential air pollution. Decision-makers should be aware of the current proximity guidelines, health risks, and design implications.
6. **5.6 Energy** (page 19): All solar panels should be screened to reduce viewshed issues. Additionally, please check with MTD to confirm if the bus stop in front of the Orchard Park neighborhood is operational. If so, please update your list of MTD stops.
7. **5.10 Land use** (page 26): Reevaluate and possibly classify items "a" and "b" in the table to Potentially Significant. The project's design is in conflict with the EGVCP guidelines to A) cluster structures rather than create one large structure, and B) place the parking behind the structures. Given the proposed access and removal of mature median landscaping to install the left turn lane, consider classifying item "i" as Potentially Significant.

(page 27): Add the former section of Calle Real (now abandoned and used by Cal-Trans as storage for equipment and materials) to the list of surrounding/adjacent properties. Also please confirm whether or not Fire Station 12 is located within the City of Goleta.

(Impact Discussion - item b): Clarify which EGVCP guidelines are being adhered to and which are being ignored/discounted (perhaps better done in section 9.0). Elaborate on the specifics on the Level of Service evaluation to ensure the broadest scope of area projects were considered (including the proposed Cottage Hospital project at Hollister and Patterson).

(**Traffic Safety**): Evaluate the length of the planned turn channel/taper into the subject in context of A) the adjacent turn lanes on Calle Real which serve the Orchard Park neighborhood and the Patterson Plus self-storage, and B) the proximity to accelerating traffic onto Calle Real (from Patterson) and the drivers' hampered visibility due to the setting sun during rush hour. Given the complexities of this intersection and the introduction of a turn lane so close to Patterson (and a turn lane that is substantially shorter than adjacent turn lanes), alternative access should be evaluated.

Accordingly, we believe it is difficult to conclude that "*The project will not impact the existing surrounding development...*" (page 28, para i)

8. **5.12 Public Facilities** (page 31- section b): Historically, students who attend Kellogg Elementary feed into Goleta Valley Junior High School and then into Dos Pueblos High School (which has traditionally been at or above capacity). While parents can petition to have their children attend San Marcos High School, it is my understanding that Dos Pueblos should be the high school of reference for evaluation in this paragraph. Please confirm with the school district.
9. **5.14 Transportation** (page 37): As mentioned previously and given the sporadic use of EGVCP guidelines (ie: clustered buildings, parking behind the structures, maintaining mountain views, etc.) we respectfully disagree that "*The project will not conflict with any plan, ordinance, or policy...*" (para a).

As referenced above, the proposed turn lane which consists of a 75' channel and a 60' taper (total 135 feet) is substantially shorter than the existing left turn lane which serves Patterson Plus Self Storage (approx. 205 feet) which likely generates far fewer ADTs. Further, the existing left turn lane into to the Orchard Park is approximately 224 feet long and serves fewer residences (20) compared to 27 units at Galileo Pisa. Further study needs to address design capacity, loss of mature landscaping, and the complexities of

the intersection and the impact of potential back-ups due to the comparatively short turn lane, and the impact of glare from the setting sun will have on drivers' views during afternoon rush hour traffic.

10. **Initial Review of Project Consistency...** (page 43-44): This section lists several EGVCP policies including some policies listed as "should" rather than "shall" which appear to have been disregarded or discounted in the current site design.
