

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA**

ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR) RESOLUTION NO. _____
COUNTY SERVICE AREA No. 41)
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025)

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has considered the Public Works Director’s recommendation for setting charges in County Service Area No. 41 for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 3522, and Resolution 85-286 were adopted on July 1, 1985 by the Board of Supervisors, establishing County Service Area No. 41; and

WHEREAS, County Service Area No. 41 was established to pay for road related repairs, maintenance and improvements pursuant to the County Service Area Law, California Government Code Section 25210 *et seq.*, which provides that for any County service area or zone thereof located therein, a County may fix and collect charges for a particular extended service authorized to pay, in whole or in part, for the cost thereof; and

WHEREAS, the current County Service Area 41 benefit assessment was initially imposed for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year based on a ten-year work plan pursuant to California Government Code Section 25215.3, California Constitution Article XIII D, Section 4, California Government Code Section 53753, and California Streets and Highways Code Section 5101.6; and

WHEREAS, the County does not propose to change the established assessment methodology for the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 3522 states charges shall be collected on the tax roll upon filing of a written report containing a description of each parcel of real property receiving the extended service, and the amount of charge for each parcel as attached in EXHIBIT “A”,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Public Works Director’s report, attached hereto as EXHIBIT “A,” is hereby confirmed and the charges therein set forth shall be collected on the 2024-2025 tax roll, on parcels located in County Service Area No. 41.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The Clerk of the Board is directed to file with the County Auditor-Controller, on or before September 20, 2024 a certified copy of this Resolution and the report, indicating adoption by the Board. Upon such filing, the County Auditor-Controller shall enter the charges on the tax roll for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. The charges shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner, and subject to the same penalties and priority of lien as, County taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of County taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the charges.



**ANNUAL CERTIFICATION OF DIRECT CHARGES
IN COMPLIANCE WITH PROPOSITION 218
FISCAL YEAR 2024-25**

As agreed by CSA 41, hereinafter referred to as “Public Agency”, and Santa Barbara County, hereinafter referred to as “County”, the Public Agency hereby certifies that the Direct Charges (encompassing non-ad valorem special taxes, assessments, fees & service charges, and/or abatements) listed below, to be placed on the County’s Secured Property Tax bills by the Public Agency, either (a) meet the requirements of Proposition 218 that added Articles XIIC and XIID to the State Constitution or (b) that the Public Agency or the specific assessments or nonproperty-related fee is exempt from the requirements of Proposition 218.

The Public Agency agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County, the Board of Supervisors, the Auditor-Controller, its officers and employees, from litigation over whether the requirements of Proposition 218 were met with respect to such Direct Charges.

If any judgment is entered against any indemnified party as a result of not meeting the requirements of Proposition 218 for such Direct Charges, the Public Agency agrees that the County may offset the amount of any judgment paid by an indemnified party from any monies collected by the County on the behalf of the Public Agency, including property taxes and Direct Charges.
