EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

The Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish Traffic Controlled Intersections by the use of Traffic Lights at the following locations:

First Supervisorial District:

- At the intersection of San Ysidro Road with Santa Rosa Lane.

Second Supervisorial District:

- At the intersection of Cathedral Oaks Road with Turnpike Road.

- At the intersection of Bradley Road with Lakeview Road.
- At the intersection of Bradley Road with Santa Maria Way.
- At the intersection of Bradley Road with Terrace Avenue.
- At the intersection of Clark Avenue with the Oak Knoll Center driveway.
- At the intersection of Clark Avenue with Orcutt Road.
- At the intersection of Clark Avenue with Stillwell Road.
