Summary Text:

On June 27, 2008, the Civil Grand Jury released a report entitled "Leadership Project: A Good Plan in Need of Transparency." The report contains five findings and recommendations primarily related to communication, the new pay system and financial impacts, and the Civil Service Commission's secretary. The Civil Grand Jury requested that the County Executive Office (CEO), the Assistant CEO/HR Director respond to all five findings and recommendations. Additionally, the Board of Supervisors must respond to all of the reports findings and recommendations (see attached for proposed responses).

Background:

The Civil Grand Jury released its report on "Leadership Project: A Good Plan in Need of Transparency" on June 27, 2008. In accordance with California Penal Code Section 933(b), the governing body of the agency (Board of Supervisors) must respond within 90 days after issuance of the report. Consequently, the Board of Supervisors" responses must be finalized and transmitted to the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court no later than September 25, 2008. The proposed Board of Supervisors" responses (attached) will be considered by the Board on September 9, 2008.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

There are no proposed fiscal impacts to the County associated with the recommendations at this time.
