SUBJECT: Temporarily Increase Special Duty Allowance for the Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor

and the Psychiatric Nurse II in the Psychiatric Health Facility

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Adopt the attached Personnel Resolution effective March 14, 2005 to authorize a Special Duty allowance of 10% for the employee in the single-position in the classification of Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor.
- 2. Adopt the attached Personnel Resolution effective March 28, 2005 to authorize a Special Duty allowance of 10% for one position allocated to the classification of Psychiatric Nurse II.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is aligned with Goals No. 2 and 3: A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work and Visit, and providing A Strong, Professionally Managed County Organization.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This Board action will provide a temporary Special Duty Allowance to the Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor to cover management responsibilities during the transition of the Division Manager of Acute Care/Forensics to a retirement status. This allowance will recognize the employee's assigned management responsibilities and allow for a well-organized transfer of responsibility.

This Board action will also provide a temporary Special Duty Allowance to the Psychiatric Nurse II to cover Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor responsibilities during this transition. This allowance will recognize the employee's assigned supervisory responsibilities and allow for a well-organized transfer of responsibility.

The Alcohol Drug and Mental Health Department anticipates that these temporary allowances will be necessary through October 9, 2005. We will return to the Board on or before October 9, 2005 to delete the allowances.

Outcomes

The Special Duty Allowances for the Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor and Psychiatric Nurse II in the Psychiatric Health Facility will help ADMHS meet **Recurring Performance Measure 0219**, to provide effective mental health services to 4,200 seriously mentally ill people.

Mandates and Service Levels:

Mental Health Services are mandated by the Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 5600. As a hospital responsible for the care of 16 acute patients daily, the PHF is subject to stringent regulatory controls. A clear authority structure is an absolute requirement. It is imperative that there is a highly trained, knowledgeable manager in place during the transition period attending the retirement of the incumbent manager.

Among the agencies who perform either unannounced or scheduled operational audits of the PHF are the federal Center for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS), the State Department of Mental Health (DMH), and the State Department of Health Services. Decertification by one of theses agencies would result in the facility becoming ineligible for Medicare and MediCal reimbursement for services (currently budgeted at \$1,624,550 annually).

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Psychiatric Nurse Supervisor salary currently is \$3,968.00 per pay period. An increase in Special Duty Allowance by 10% increases this amount to \$4,365.00 which is a difference of \$396.00 per pay period. This temporary assignment will last for fifteen pay periods and will terminate on October 9, 2005. The increase of approximately \$5,953.00 will be absorbed through Fiscal Year 04-05 and through Fiscal Year 05-06 budget of the ADMHS Department.

The Psychiatric Nurse II salary currently is \$3,275.00 per pay period. An increase in Special Duty Allowance by 10% increases this amount to \$3,603.00 which is a difference of \$327.00 per pay period. This temporary assignment will last for fourteen pay periods and will terminate on October 9, 2005. The increase of approximately \$4,585.00 will be absorbed through Fiscal Year 04-05 and through Fiscal Year 05-06 budget of the ADMHS Department.
