WHEREAS, the Santa Ynez Library first opened in 1910 in the College Hotel and is the first county branch building in the state of California; and

WHEREAS, the community had a dinner dance and raised funds for a separate building for the Santa Ynez library which was built in 1912; and

WHEREAS, in 1972 the library was moved one block west to its present location; and

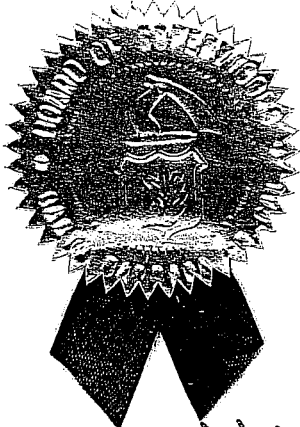
WHEREAS, in 1977 the Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors designated the library Santa Barbara County Historical Landmark No. 11; and

WHEREAS, the library has been in continuous operation for one hundred years; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Ynez Library remains as an active reminder of the community's esteem for history and the importance of its libraries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors hereby celebrates the 100th Anniversary of the Santa Ynez Library.
