WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and maintaining local used oil collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate disposal of used oil; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara will enter into an agreement with the State of California for implementation of a used oil collection program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Public Works Department to submit a grant application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a 2009/2010 Used Oil Recycling Block Grant (15th Cycle).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Works Director of the County of Santa Barbara, or his or her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the County of Santa Barbara all necessary grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant program.
