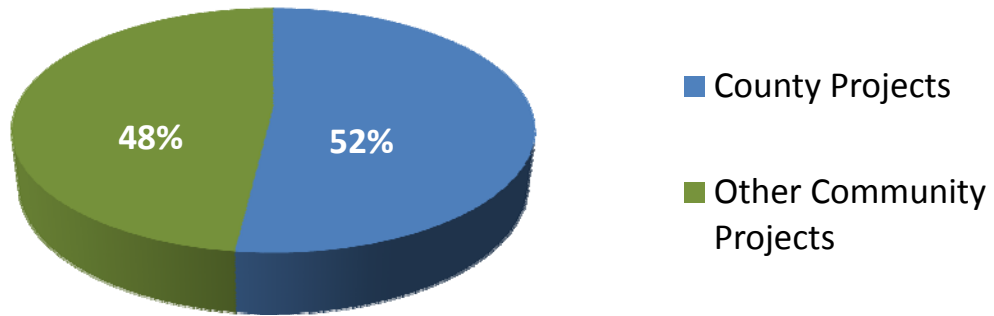

2009	New Cuyama Recreation Center Rehabilitation	Rehabilitation of this community building serving the low income community of New Cuyama.	\$353,766
2010	County Health Clinic Elevator Reactivation	Repair and modernization of two elevators in the County Public Health Clinic, resulting in the removal of barriers for the disabled population.	\$300,000
2010	New Cuyama Modular Community Center	Purchase of a modular building to serve as a community library in the low income community of New Cuyama.	\$250,000
2010	Housing Activity Delivery Costs	Activity costs associated with affordable housing projects (administration of Federal compliance requirements such as environmental review, contract preparation, bid packet review and other supplementary program-related regulations).	\$ 79,587
