### **Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for construction of the Tajiguas Landfill Access Road Realignment, County Project No. 720684 (Resource Recovery & Waste Management Division Project No. 828349); and
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$716,532.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Granite Construction Company, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project, as required under California Law: and
- C. Authorize the Chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents and the approval of County Counsel, Auditor Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives: and
- D. Approve contingency fund in the amount of \$48,326.60 for construction of the Tajiguas Landfill Access Road Realignment, County Project No. 720684 (Resource Recovery & Waste Management Division Project No. 828349).

### **Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No.2 to ensure the public's health and safety.

### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

As part of the Tajiguas Landfill Expansion Project it is necessary to stockpile excess soil. To allow for stockpiling, the landfill main access road will need realignment. This project to realign the road is consistent with the environmental impact report for the Tajiguas Landfill Expansion Project and we have continued to work with the regulatory agencies on the development of the project.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsible bidder. The Department has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$716,532.00. The Department recommends awarding this contract to Granite Construction Company.

#### **Mandates and Service Levels:**

This project will not change the level of service.

## **Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

This project is included in the Proposed 2005/06 Budgets. Costs for this project will be paid from Dept: 054, Act: 8200, Fund: 1930, Program: 1750.
