This fee resolution is to replace County Resolution 07-321 for fees collected by the County Surveyor for subdivision map and document review due to an inadvertent clerical error in the previously adopted fee resolution.				
Background:				
The County Board of Supervisors recently adopted County Resolution 07-321 on October 16, 2007 for the purpose of adding fees for the review of projects subject to Chapter 21A of the County Code. Other minor enhancements were adopted at the same time but a previously adopted customer service enhancement (expedited processing) was inadvertently omitted. This fee resolution also adds the ability to charge overtime in certain situations for expedited processing for the convenience of the applicant.
