Water damage cleanup, mold mitigation, structural drying and demolition, emergency repairs of drywall, flooring, paint and locker replacement at the Sheriffs Bailiff offices, Santa Barbara County Courthouse East Wing basement area. Damaged storm drain repair, and restore access to essential services and protect existing Sheriffs facilities and property. Work was in response to the January 4 and January 9, 2023 storm events, during which a Local Emergency was declared by the Director of Emergency Services on January 9, 2023 and Board Resolution 23-5. A Proclamation of a State of Emergency was issued by the Governor on January 4, 2023. A Federal Declaration of Emergency (EM3591-CA) and ultimately a Federally Declared Disaster (DR 4683) was made by the President on January 14, 2023.



Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the time of filing a Notice of Determination (Pub. Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5). Without the appropriate fee, statutory or categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), the Notice of Determination is not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

### COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the environmental filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5, subd. (g)(1)). A county board of supervisors shall have the authority to increase or decrease the fee or charge, that is otherwise authorized to be levied by another provision of law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the cost of providing any product or service or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee or charge is levied (Gov. Code, § 54985, subd. (a)).

#### **DOCUMENT RETENTION**
