Executive Summary and Discussion:

The Employees' University (EU) is the County's corporate university. Established in 1998, the EU is tied to your Board's Strategic plan and is focused on providing skill development and learning opportunities for the enhancement of every employee. In March 1999, your Board accepted a report from the Employees' University Governing Council, which provided an update on progress made since the EU was initiated. Since then, the EU has not only expanded to meet the County's training needs but has developed a number of public-private partnerships to benefit to the County organization, other jurisdictions, community agencies, and ultimately the residents we serve.
