## **Scope of Work Overview**

The County of Santa Barbara shall:

- Administer the grant;
- Develop the Project Action Plan, under guidance and direction of the Office of Planning & Research (OPR);
- Convene grant subrecipients for regular meetings;
- · Conduct evaluation activities, under guidance and direction of OPR; and
- Participate in peer-to-peer (P2P) learning activities led by OPR and conduct additional P2P activities.

## Community Environmental Council (CEC) shall:

- Attend regular Resilience Hub meetings;
- Support the development of the Project Action Plan;
- Provide community outreach and engagement support to the grant subrecipients;
- Convene and facilitate community-specific committees or working groups on behalf of the Resilience Hubs; and
- Develop a Resilience Hub toolkit providing resources, best practices, and lessons learned for future Resilience Hubs to be established.

Resilience Hub (City of Santa Barbara, Blue Sky Center, Girls Inc. of Carpinteria) shall:

- Attend regular Resilience Hub meetings;
- Lead community outreach and engagement activities with support from CEC; and
- Procure equipment and labor to install microgrid systems with photovoltaic solar panels, battery energy storage systems, and microgrid controls.
