That the Board of Supervisors and the Board of Directors of the Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District execute the attached <u>Easement Deed</u> conveying an easement for ingress and egress over the Flood Control District's parcel commonly known as the Rodeo-San Pasqual Channel (APN# 093-100-027) to landlocked property owners, Raymond L. Cagianut and Judith A. Cagianut, owners of 386 La Salle Canyon Road (APN# 093-100-076).

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is aligned with Goal No. 1. An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The County and the Flood Control District acquired the Rodeo-San Pasqual Channel APN# 093-100-027 on December 7, 1962. This acquisition land locked the parcel at 386 La Salle Canyon Road APN# 093-100-076. On September 9, 1983, Flood Control granted a Right of Entry to Raymond Cagianut over the Rodeo-San Pasqual Channel parcel APN# 093-100-027 which has been used until the present day. Raymond L. Cagianut and Judith A. Cagianut, owners of 386 La Salle Canyon Road APN# 093-100-076 now want to sell their land and the Right of Entry does not transfer with ownership. The Cagianuts have therefore asked the County and the Flood Control District for a permanent easement for ingress and egress over this parcel so they can sell their land with legal access to the lot.
