After lots of back and forth, we were able to get the charges covered. However, this is one example of many landlords in Isla Vista taking advantage of the community and giving tenants unsafe living conditions. As a constituent, I ask that the Board allows for the passing of the Isla Vista Rental Housing Inspection Pilot Program. This program would protect leasers and prevent further issues from happening and would stop landlords from punishing them.
