AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA AMENDING SECTION 2-10.8 TO THE COUNTY CODE TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE COUNTY TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 2-10.8 of Article 1 of Chapter 2 of the County Code be amended to read as follows:

Section 2-10.8 Office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector-Public Guardian/Administrator fees

Pursuant to California Revenue and Taxation Code sections 2621, 2706, 2821, 2922, 4102, and 4217 *et seq.*; and pursuant to California Government Code sections 54985 and 66018, the County Treasurer-Tax Collector shall charge the following service fees:

- (a) For processing of delinquent secured property tax payment, Thirty Dollars (\$30.00);
- (b) For processing of delinquent unsecured tax payment, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00);
- (c) For processing of delinquent secured property tax installment payment plans, One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$175.00);
- (d) For processing of subdivision parcel split of combination security, One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00);
- (e) For processing of lot line adjustment security, One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00).
- (f) For processing of an application for separate valuation, One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
- (g) For redemption of tax defaulted property, Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) of which Five Dollars (\$5.00) is distributed to the State per Revenue and Taxation Code section 4656.5.

SECTION 2: That all fees collected under this Section shall be transmitted to the County Treasurer, and an amount equal thereto shall be used to pay the costs of providing services set forth in this ordinance.

SECTION 3: That, as permitted by California Government Code section 54985, the fees allowed by this ordinance reflect the amount necessary to recover the cost of providing the services for which these fees are charged.

SECTION 4: That all other fees of the Treasurer-Tax Collector-Public Guardian/Administrator shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: That, upon a showing of good cause, the Board of Supervisors may, by minute order or resolution, adjust or waive the fees set forth in this ordinance.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance, in the Santa Barbara News-Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California.
