

<p>This plan substantially complies with the 2 main legal considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - It has basically equal population in each district. Additional block adjustments could be made if the Supervisors want to reduce the minor deviation that still exists. - There is no racial discrimination, avoiding fragmentation, dilution of minority voting and packing. 		
Briefly describe the goals of your plan (example: keep rural areas together, keep a city in a specific district, etc.)		
<p>This plan harmonizes all the considerations Supervisors have the option of considering including keeping together communities of interest and county election precincts, preserving compactness and contiguity and avoiding gerrymandering.</p> <p>In addition it minimizes voter disenfranchisement. It moves a minimal amount of people from one district to another, to provide the following benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Preserve relationships between Supervisors and residents currently in their jurisdictions - Minimize the number of people who will be moved to Supervisors for whom they did not have the opportunity to vote - Minimize the number of people who expected to vote in 2 years having to wait an extra 2 years (a total of 6 from their last vote for Supervisor.

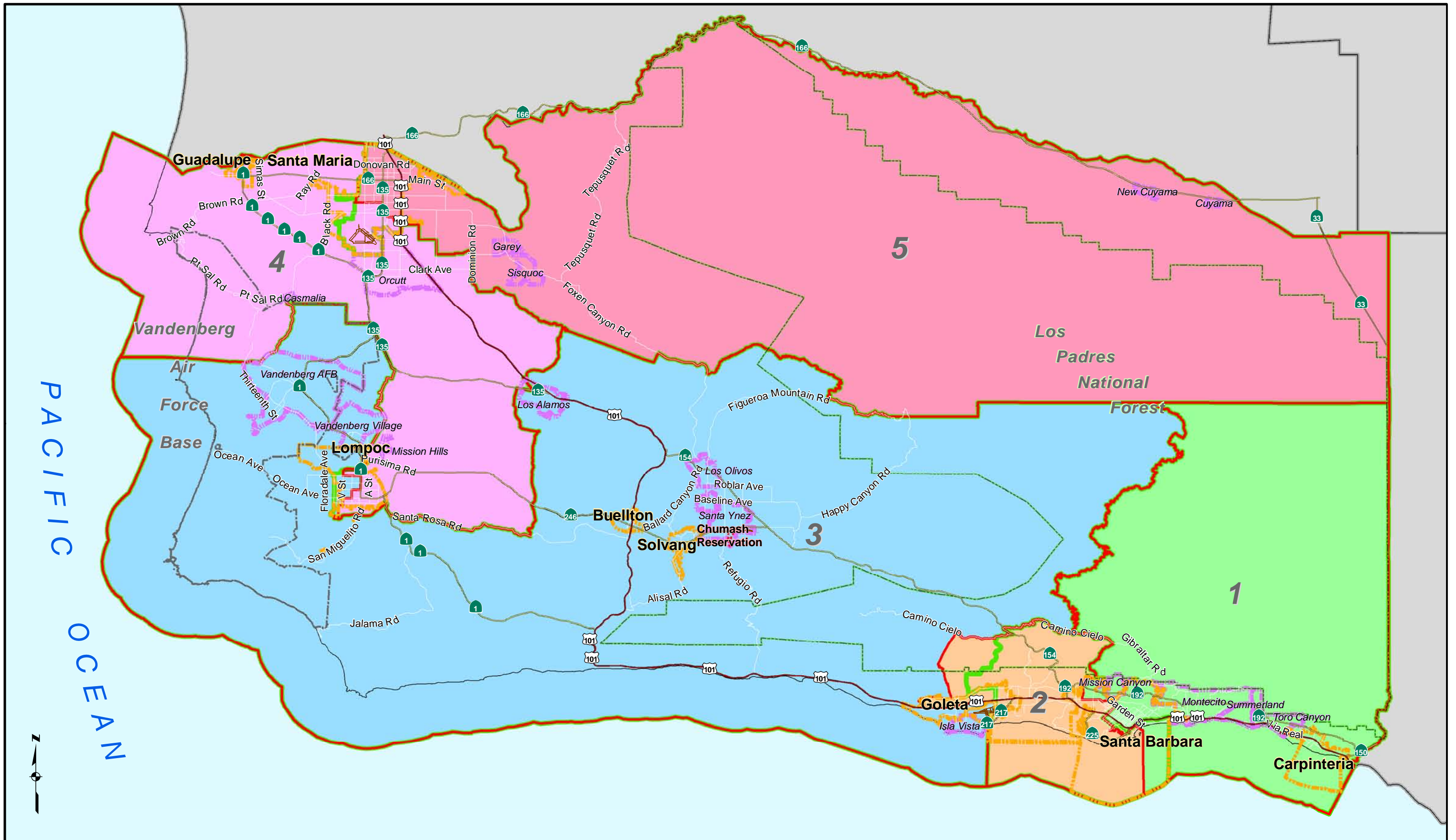

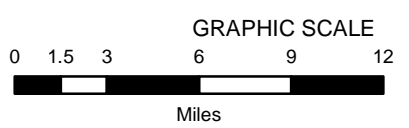

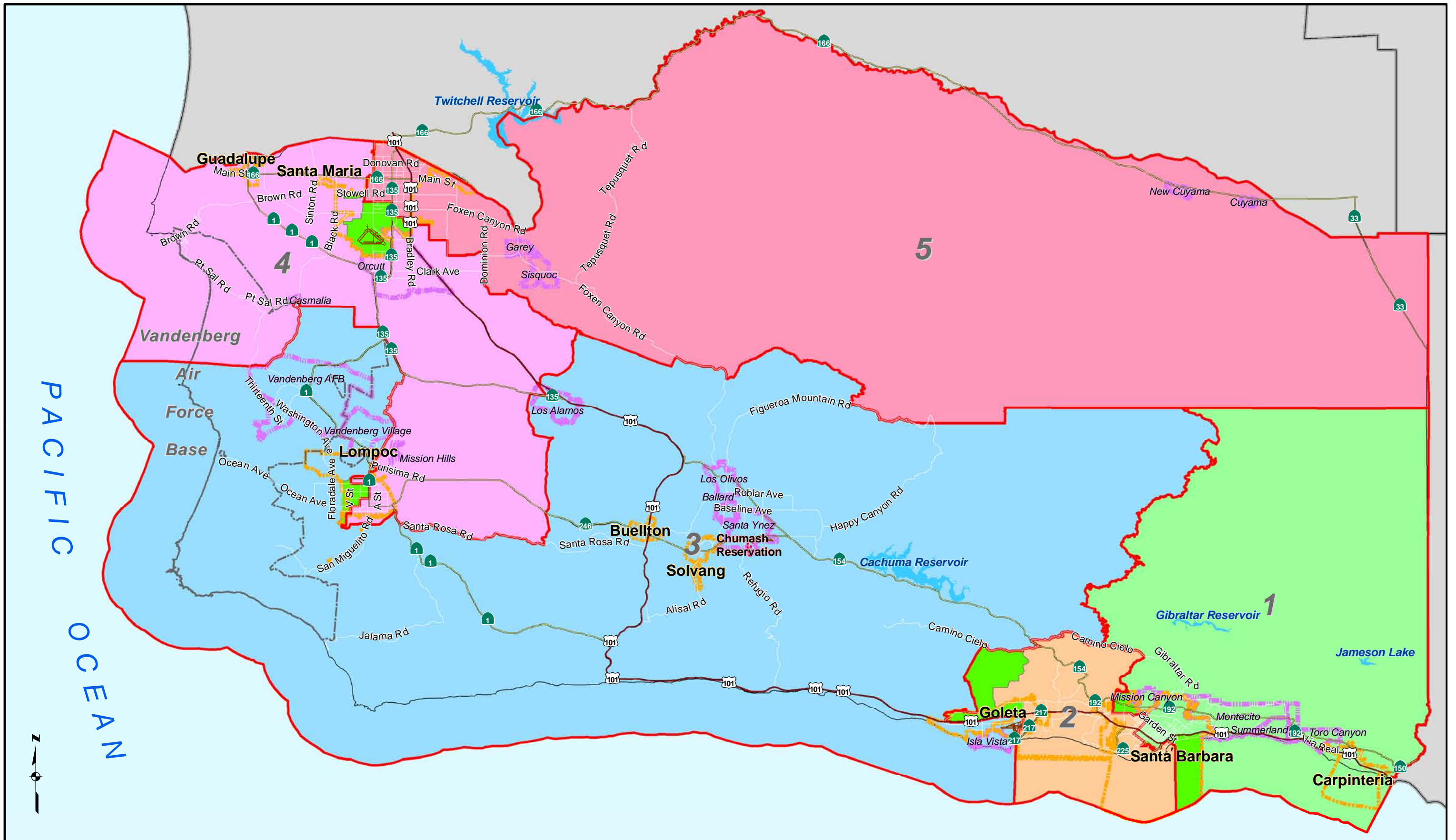
Supervisory Districts, Santa Barbara County
MVP plan 1 Overview

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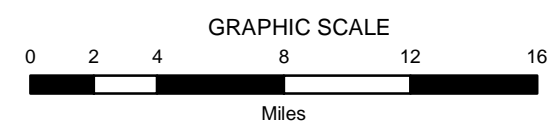
