WHEREAS, Morris Jurkowitz served as a Santa Barbara City College Trustee from 2003-2012; and

WHEREAS, as resident of Santa Barbara for almost 50 years, Morris "Morrie" Jurkowitz has always made giving back to the community a priority in his life. He and his wife Irma are avid supporters of many causes, including higher education, the arts, and human services; and

WHEREAS, through his more than 24 years of service to SBCC, Mr. Jurkowitz has embraced and built on the philosophy of giving a helping hand to students in need. In 1988 through the Foundation for SBCC, the Jurkowitzes established a special honor program award that provides needed scholarships each year to deserving students with high academic standings; and

WHEREAS, in 1991, Mr. Jurkowitz joined the Foundation Board, a position he has held continuously until the current time. In 2003, he expanded his involvement at SBCC by accepting appointment to the SBCC District Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Jurkowitzes have also shared their commitment to the arts with SBCC by funding the Jurkowitz Theatre on the school's West Campus. The state-of-the-art small theatre provides a unique, intimate theatrical experience for the entire community; and

WHEREAS, in addition to education, Mr. Jurkowitz had devoted his energies to numerous other important causes. He has served on the boards of the Cancer Center of Santa Barbara, the Unity Shoppe, the Santa Barbara Girls Club (now Girls Inc.), and the Jewish Federation of Greater Santa Barbara. He also has been a supporter of the Dream Foundation, the Hillel House at UCSB, and the Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse.
