### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve the plans and specifications for the Betteravia Building "C" HVAC Replacement Project # T02005. Plans and specifications for this project are available from General Services Facilities Division.
- b) Award Brannon Inc., dba Smith Electric Service (a Local Contractor) a contract for \$605,033 for the Betteravia Building "C" HVAC Replacement Project.
- c) Authorize the Director of General Services to approve change orders of an amount not to exceed 10% of the base amount of \$250,000 plus 5% of the bid in excess of the base amount or \$42,751.65 for this contract.
- d) Approve the Categorical Exemption pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for 15301 (a),(d),

#### **Summary Text:**

This project will replace the failing heating and cooling units on the building's roof, as well as replacing the leaking pneumatic controls and compressor for the fan coils located inside the building. The project was advertised and a job walk was held and attended by four local and one out-of -County contractor. Two contractors ultimately bid the job. Smith Electric, a local contractor had the lowest responsive bid.

A CEQA categorical exemption is being requested for this project, as it consists of maintenance, repair, and alteration of an existing public structure with no expansion, in accordance with CEQA Guidelines 15301 (a)(d).

## **Background:**

Betteravia Building "C" is a three story building that utilizes three large multizone McQuay heating/cooling units that supply hot and cold water to 65 fan coils in the building that condition the air in the building as needed. The three McQuay units have severely damaged coils that are leaking and cannot economically be repaired. Additionally the pneumatic controls that are original to the building are also failing. The pneumatic controls are no longer manufactured and parts to replace the failed controls are non-existent.
