Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors accept and file the Certified Statement of the Results of the Official Canvass and Official Election Summary for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election held on September 14, 2021, and declare the results as specified in the Certified Statement as required by law.

Summary Text:

The results of the September 14, 2021, California Gubernatorial Recall Election were certified on October 11, 2021. Elections Code § 15372 requires the Registrar of Voters to prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to the governing body within 30 days of the election. An official Certification of County Clerk/Registrar of Voters of the Results of the Canvass (Attachment A), Certified Results Election Summary Report (Attachment B), Official Canvass of Votes for Qualified Write-In Replacement Candidates (Attachment C) are attached. The Statement of Votes Cast by precinct for the election is available on the Clerk, Recorder and Assessor & Registrar of Voters website at www.sbcvote.com.

Election Code § 15400 requires that the governing body declare elected to each office voted on at the election the person having the highest number of votes for that office or who was elected or nominated under the exceptions noted in Election Code § 15452. The governing board shall also declare the results of the election for each measure under its jurisdiction.

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Elections Code § 15620 allows any voter, within five days, but not later than 5:00 pm on the fifth day, following the completion of the canvass, to file a request for recount with the county elections official of the votes cast for candidates for any office, or any measure provided that the office or measure is not voted on statewide. The "completion of the canvass" shall be presumed to be that time when the elections official signs the certified statement of the results of the election. As the signing of the certified statement occurred on Monday, October 11, 2021, the written request for a recount must be filed with the elections official no later than 5:00 pm on Saturday, October 16, 2021. The deadline for filing a written request for a recount has been posted on our website along with the certified results.

Elections Code § 15621 allows any voter within five days beginning the 31st day after a statewide election to file with the Secretary of State a request for a recount of votes cast for candidates for any statewide office or any proposition voted on statewide.
