








Hospital Capacity, 8/30




% Staffed Adult ICU Beds in Use

1 in 3 eligible persons in Santa Barbara County is unvaccinated



Vaccines

	Third Dose	Booster Dose
Who	Only for immunocompromised population	For everyone else who have received 2 doses
Why	Immune system not at sufficient level with only two doses	Immune system reached sufficient level with two doses
How	Third dose brings immune system up to a sufficient level	Booster dose "boosts" their immune system because the immune response wanes after a certain amount of time
When	Able to receive 28 days after 2 nd dose. After 8/12	Able to receive 8 months after 2 nd dose. Tentative 9/20
Which	EUA only for Pfizer and Moderna vaccines	Pending review of Pfizer and Moderna by FDA
Where	Healthcare providers; hospitals, pharmacies	Healthcare providers, hospitals, pharmacies, Public Health community sites
